



TIME FOR THE PERFECT SWING

With the typical quietness of a desert island, the brightness of the sea and white sand constantly in the field of vision, the sea breeze blowing gently in the top of the pines and surrounded with one of the most beautiful natural reserves of the country, becomes difficult to imagine a scenario more relaxing and perfect for golf. If to this set of natural factors, you add the field architecture designed by Robert Trent Jones Senior, one of the most famous and demanding golf architects of all time, certainly we are talking about the Troia golf Championship Course.

Ranked by the magazine "Golf World" as the 20th best golf course in Europe, and considered by the "Golf Digest" One of the top 100 golf courses outside the United States of America, the Troia golf is regularly considered one of the most fascinating challenges of national Golf. This recognition is due to his track with small "greens", well modulated and well protected by bunkers, and narrow fairways and surrounded by dunes and pine trees, offering a real test to the ability of players with a low handicap and a stimulating challenge to the more modest player. The first nine holes are along the beach, with magnificent views of the sea, and Robert Trent Jones elected the hole 3 of Tróia, as one of the best he ever designed included as part of his ideal 18 holes course.

Adding existing high environmental standards, troia golf Championship Course has been awarded in 2010 with the Eco-Golf certification by TÜV Rheinland, becoming the only Portuguese golf course with this certification.

During the recent renovations, a new Clubhouse was developed by the Portuguese architect João Paciência, in a contemporary style of lines and imposing facades of glass and wood, resulting in a seamless integration with the surrounding nature. Used not only by golfers, it has a privileged view over the golf course, and integrates quality services, as the reception of golf, shop, meeting room, bar and restaurant with a terrace with magnificent views over the countryside and Arrábida mountain.
